

Completion of Cabin Retreat Complex in Jeopardy

The footer was poured; the walls went up and the roof went on. All this in freezing weather during the middle of an Erie winter.

Now the weather is breaking and spring is showing up all around us. But will the new Camp Judson Cabin and Retreat Complex get completed for the summer camping season, or even the fall retreat season? It all depends on lots of those green dollar bills arriving at camp this spring or soon thereafter.

Yes, we are in great need of funds. To complete the complex and bring a new gas line to the camp, we need an additional \$150,000 right away.

There are many ways you can help in this project. The first is to pray. The second is to give. Here are some examples of giving which you could sign up for:

750 people to give \$200 now or within two month.

The longer it takes to pay for this building the more money it costs us, and that is just poor stewardship on all of our part.
