This one day event will be led by Rev. Dr. David Greenhaw, President and Professor of Preaching at Eden Seminary, St. Louis, Missouri. Rev. Dr. Greenhaw received his Bachelor's Degree from the University of Kansas, attended Eden Theological Seminary where he earned his Master of Divinity, and completed his Ph.D. at Drew University. He is an ordained minister of the United Church of Christ and is a frequent guest preacher in congregations and church gatherings. Rev. Dr. Greenhaw lectures and publishes on the revitalization of mainline Protestantism.

Rev. Dr. Greenhaw is an engaging and informative lecturer who interacts with his audience at a high energy level. This dynamic educational event will begin with an ecumenical hour of worship with Rev. Dr. Greenhaw preaching. Worship will be followed by a morning plenary session, lunch, and an afternoon session comprised of large group worship, review and analysis of the last sermon of Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and review of the sermons of several local presenters.
